The event

AYPH is running a multi-disciplinary conference on young people's health in London on 21 February 2018, to celebrate our 10th anniversary. The event will be attended by researchers, students, health professionals, education professionals, voluntary sector and youth professionals, commissioners and policy makers. There will also be contributions from young people concerning their experiences and how best to co-produce services.

The conference will highlight the latest research around young people's health and wellbeing and explore the case for investing in this age group. There will be a particular focus on what has changed in the last 10 years, and how we need to work differently to meet young people's health needs in the future.

Topics for submissions

We welcome submission relating to published research, research in progress, clinical developments and innovations in practice.

How to submit your abstract

Potential contributors should submit an abstract of maximum 250 words for oral presentation or posters. Please use the attached abstract submission form, or download the form from the AYPH website.

Only a small number of papers will be accepted for oral presentation; the majority of presentations will be posters. Authors will be notified of the outcome of their submission by 20 December 2017.
